

CENTRAL COAST DISTRICT GOLF ASSOCIATION

ORDER OF MERIT.

The Central Coast District Golf Association (CCDGA) are running an Order of merit (OOM) contest for CCDGA amateur golfers. The OOM will not only recognise the golfing achievements throughout the year, but also recognise participation and support of District Events including District Pennants.

The OOM event is open to any amateur golfer who is a full playing member of a CCDGA Golf club. Entry to the event is automatic.

The OOM will be a useful tool to identify potential representative players however other factors will also be taken into consideration when picking District Teams. Standing in the OOM does not guarantee automatic selection in such squads.

The OOM contest will be points based and the golfer with the most points at the end of the season wins.

The points break up will be similar to the points allocated via the USPGA Fed Ex Cup allocation.

In stroke events, maximum points for the event will be allocated to the highest placed CCDGA player down to the 20th placed player plus ties. In the event of ties the points allocated for those positions will be added together and then divided by the amount of persons tied. In the event of a large tie for 20 place, no player in such tie will score less than that of someone who is getting participation points.

MAJOR EVENTS

The major events are:

The CCDGA District Championships.

The Regional Championships.

The NSW Country Championships.

(See scale below for points allocation. Points start from 500)

The Tony Lamaro Match play event.

Players who progress through to the top 16 in the Tony Lamaro Match play will receive 50 points. Top 8 will receive 100 points. Top 4 will receive 170 points, Runner up 300 points and the winner 500 points. NB. Players must complete their match to receive points. Forfeits will forfeit point allocations for the current round the player is in. Points are not accumulative.

DISTRICT CLUB EVENTS

All CCDGA Club Cup/Vardon events.

(See scale below for points allocation. Points start from 500)

CCDGA A GRADE PENNANTS.

It has been decided to allocate points for participation in CCDGA Pennant events whilst still rewarding individual wins as well as participation. After much consultation, the points allocation will be 30 points for an individual win regardless of player position (One through to Reserve) and 10 points for a loss. In the event of a tied match both players receive 20 points.
