2018 Hope Mullard Morisset Amateur Open — Conditions of Play

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run by Golf NSW. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on this form take precedence.

1. Event Procedure

- 1.1 The 2018 Open will be stroke play of 18 holes.
- 1.2 A timesheet will be used to determine participant tee times on Saturday 3rd March 2018.
- 1.3 TIES: In the event of a tie for the open stroke the winner will be determined by **SUDDEN DEATH** Play off that will be held on the day using Holes 1,9,10 and 18 until a winner is determined.

2. Match Committee

- 2.1 Match Committee will comprise the Morisset Golf Club Captain, President and Tournament Director or their nominated representatives.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Match Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 2.3 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- **3. Rules of Play**: The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited will apply, together with any additional Local Rules as determined by the Match Committee.
- **4. Entries:** Eligible players are amateur male golfers with a Golf Australia Handicap who are members of a Golf NSW affiliated golf club.
- **5. Motorised Transport**: Motorised transport is permitted across all grades. If players wish to use golf carts, they must book these directly with the Pro Shop on 49732455. Morisset Golf Club takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.
- **6. Suspension or Cancellation of play:** Whilst rain, in itself, is not a reason to suspend or cancel play the committee may take this action in the event electrical storms, high winds, flooded greens or any condition that may be deemed to present a danger to the players or the course becomes unplayable. The following signals will be used.

Discontinue play immediately 1 prolonged note of a siren.

Resume play 2 short notes of the siren repeated

Event cancelled Continuous siren blast

- 7. Registration: Competitors MUST register at least 30 minutes before starting time on the day of play.
- **8. Pace of Play**: Rule 6.7 will be strictly enforced with all players being held responsible for the speed of play of their group.
- **9. Trophies**: Prizes will be awarded for both Scratch and Nett events. Prizes are limited to one per person, except nearest the pins and long drives
- **10.** Other: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted. Caddies are permitted.
