CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- Events are open to all women with Golf Australia Handicaps. **GA handicap and Golfink number to be provided** on entry form. ("Club" and "Social" handicaps not acceptable)
- **Everglades women members with Silver or Rookie memberships (or women from other clubs who do not have full golf membership) can enter and win the Event of the Day but not the Honour Board events of Salver, Bowl and Longmarker's Cup.**
- The Rules of Golf and local rules of Everglades Country Club shall be the rules during the tournament.
- All disputes shall be decided by a committee appointed for that purpose and all decisions shall be final. The committee reserves the right to refuse entry or to alter the conditions of any event.
- Golf Australia method of count back applies to all events.
- No player is eligible for more than one trophy – excluding Ball Comp., NTP's, Long Drives.
- The divisions will be in **Daily Handicap** and all players must compete in the division to which their handicap applies.
- Entry fees are not refundable **within 72 hours**.
- Players must report to the starter 20 minutes before hit-off time.
- Non-professional caddies are permitted.
- Carts are permitted
- Mobile phones - Players or caddies, who have a medical or valid reason to have their mobile switched on, must inform the Captain prior to hit-off. Should the Captain agree the reason is substantial, the player or caddie must have the phone switched to mute mode. PENALTY: - Disqualification.
- Distance Measuring Devices and Smartphones – a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used. Accessing weather reports through an app. on a smartphone is not considered to be actively measuring or gauging the conditions and is permissible.
