The club reserves the right to limit the number of entries by ballot, if necessary. The entry fee of any player balloted out will be refunded. There will be no refund to any player who withdraws after the draw is made, or who is disqualified.

Open to Members of Affiliated Clubs with the following Golf Australia Handicap limits:

Senior Men – GA H'cap limit 12 Senior Men are 55 years and over.

No player may win more than one major trophy on the day.

In the event of a tie for 1st place a sudden death playoff will be held at the conclusion of the competition or at a time determined by the Match Committee and will be on holes as determined by the Match Committee. All other divisions will be determined by the count back system.

The trophy order is as follows:

18-hole Scratch winner

18-hole Scratch runner-up

18-hole Nett winner

18-hole Nett runner-up

18-hole Seniors Scratch winner

18-hole Seniors Nett win

Play will be from the black daily markers.

The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of golf and any Local Rules of the day. The members of the Club Match Committee shall constitute the "Committee" within the meaning of the Rules of Golf. The Committee may make Local Rules for the events.

Players must register with the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their hit off time.

Slow Play – Players who fail to maintain their place in the field may incur a 2stroke penalty. Mobile Phones – The use of a mobile phone by a competitor or his caddy, whilst on the golf course during an event is prohibited. Penalty = Disqualification. Use of a mobile phone is defined as a phone which rings.

No stopping at halfway – Players are always to proceed directly to the next tee during the round. Use of golf carts will not be permitted during competition play unless a medical certificate is provided or authorized by the Captains.

Scores are to be recorded in the Club's computer system, and then the cards are to be returned to the pro shop. The score card is the final record for determining results.

Distance Measuring Devices are allowed as long as they comply with Rules of Golf, Rule 4.3. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter these conditions and any decisions of the Match Committee will be final.
