2019 CARLTON TOUKLEY CUP TERMS OF THE COMPETITION.

Eligible players are amateur male golfers who hold a current Golf Australia handicap.

Entry fee is \$25.00 per player, payable on the day.

The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any Local Rules of the day.

Handicaps: Individual handicap is your calculated daily handicap for the Toukley Blue course (slope rating 125).

A Grade: +10-12 B Grade: 13-18 C Grade: 19-36

Trophies: The Toukley Cup winner is for the lowest 18 hole scratch score on the day. In the event of a tie for the Toukley Cup, joint winners will be declared. All other prizes will be determined by count back.

The three major prizes will be given in the following order: -

1. Toukley Cup winner 2. Toukley Cup r/u 3. Nett winner over the field

Other prizes will be given in each grade in the following order:

1. Nett winner 2. Scratch winner 3. Nett R/U 4. Nett 3rd 5. Nett 4th.

There is a limit of one prize per player (exceptions: ntps, long drives etc.)

Carts etc: Use of golf carts or other motorised transport is permitted for all players. All hire golf carts are to be booked through the Pro Shop. The Match Committee takes no responsibility for the availability of hire carts. There is a \$6.00 daily license fee for private carts used on the golf course. Caddies are permitted for all players.

Mobile Phones: The use of a mobile phone by a player or his caddy is prohibited whilst on the golf course. The penalty for breach of this condition is two strokes. If a player is in possession of a mobile phone it must be set to "silent".

Exceptions:

A player who is "on call" due to his profession or civic duties may be granted permission by the Match Committee to use the phone during the event.

During the event, a player may use a mobile phone to help in an emergency.

Suspension or Cancellation of play: Whilst rain, in itself, is not a reason to suspend or cancel play the committee may take this action in the event of electrical storms or adverse weather conditions which present a danger to competitors or render the course unplayable. The following signals will be used:

Discontinue play immediately	1 x long note of the siren
Resume play	2 x short notes of the siren
Play Abandoned	1 x prolonged note of the siren

The competition is run by the Toukley Golf Club Match Committee. Their decisions are final in all matters relating to the competition. Any disputes must be reported to the Match Committee within 15 minutes of the completion of the round.
