GOSFORD GOLF CLUB – SUNDAY 15 JUNE 2025

RULES OF THE COMPETITION AND FORMAT

1. The event is to be conducted in three (3) grades with the following divisions to apply:

| “C” Grade | 17.0 – 35.3 (GA) | “C” Grade | 29.2 – 43.5 (GA) |

Players who qualify for the Challenge Cup MUST play in the grade in which they qualified to represent their Club BUT off their current handicap. They MUST also play in the host Club’s event of the day for which they will be charged members rates.

2. All players will be provided with a score card which MUST be used. Scores returned electronically will not be accepted. On completion of the round please process your card through the kiosk in the clubhouse precinct and then hand it to the CCDGA representative. The event is to be played in accord with the Rules of Golf and the local rules of Gosford Golf Club on the day. It is the players responsibility to acquaint themselves with the local rules.

3. Trophies will be awarded on the following basis:

- a. Winners over the field (Men and Women)
- b. Winners of each grade (Men and Women)
- c. Major Trophy – The Challenge Cup – to the Club whose team (3 men and 3 women) return the best aggregate stableford score.

Apart from the team prize only one (1) trophy per player will be awarded.

Trophies will be presented at Gosford Golf Club on conclusion of the event.

4. In the event of a tie for The Challenge Cup the Club with the highest individual score wins. If still tied the second highest individual score wins etc. All other ties will be decided by countback.
